The following information will help guide you through the process of taking the home study Real Estate Non-Resident Course to become a real estate salesperson on Prince Edward Island. Should you have any questions on these requirements, please contact the Prince Edward Island Real Estate Association at the above contact information.

PLEASE NOTE: An applicant has to hold a current real estate license and/or was active in the last 24 months and be a member in good standing in their current / past jurisdiction. If applicant has not been active in the last 24 months, they will be required to take the Real Estate Pre-Licensing Course at a cost of \$3,500. + Applicable taxes. Contact the Prince Edward Island Real Estate Association for scheduled dates.

To receive your Non-Resident Package, please return this signed application to the Prince Edward Island Real Estate Association with the following:

- (1) a copy of your real estate salesperson license and/or your Broker license
- (2) Non-Resident **Package fee of \$1,200. + Applicable taxes** (cheque, certified cheque or money order). **This fee is non-refundable. NOTE: the cost of delivery of the Non-Resident Package is the responsibility of the receiver (approx \$35-\$75 depending on where it is being shipped).**

The information on the application **WILL BE** verified in the jurisdiction you trade in.

This package includes six (6) sets of questions that must be completed and submitted back to the Prince Edward Island Real Estate Association **within 90 days** of purchasing the Non-Resident Package. - Applicants will be notified within ten (10) business days with mark results. A passing mark is 75%.

NOTE: When applying for your PEI Provincial Real Estate License you must show proof of your passing mark (letter from the PEIREA) and a letter from the Broker Office where you will be hired (if applicable).
