THE PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND REAL ESTATE ASSOCIATION'S REALTORS CARE® BURSARY

- PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Bursary is to provide funds for the continuing education of the dependants of REALTOR® Members, their support staff and/or employees of the Prince Edward Island Real Estate Association.
- REQUIREMENTS:** Applicants for this Bursary must be dependants of Members, Member's support staff or employees of the Prince Edward Island Real Estate Association. Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited post-secondary education institution.
- MEMBERS:** Members of the Prince Edward Island Real Estate Association eligible, includes any and all Broker/Agents or Salespeople who are active due paying Members and who have no outstanding arrears owing to the Association in advance of 30 days or who are on medical leave of absence. In addition, Member's support staff and personnel employed by the Association are eligible.
- ADMINISTRATION:** The REALTORS Care® Bursary will be administered by the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors of the Prince Edward Island Real Estate Association. The President of the PEIREA will act as Chairman of the Bursary Committee. Applications will be made to the Executive Officer, PEI Real Estate Association, 75 St. Peter's Road, Charlottetown, PE, C1A 5N7. The Bursary will be paid following proof of acceptance and registration. This is to be accompanied by a letter stating why you feel you should be awarded this Bursary.
- AMOUNT OF BURSARY:** The Bursary fund will be capped at \$2000.00 per annum.
- DISTRIBUTION:** The distribution and division of the Bursary funds will be awarded to one or two worthy applicant selected by the Committee.
- FUNDING OF:** The Bursary will be funded through an annual donation made by the Association from its Foundation Trust Account and/or in addition from donations and/or special projects specifically designated for this fund.
- BURSARY:** Additional Bursaries and/or scholarships may be made available through the PEI Real Estate Association from time to time and will be promoted among the Membership, as they are approved and available.

WHAT IS REQUIRED:

- Letter from your dependant stating why they feel they should be awarded the bursary
- Proof of acceptance / registration at a post-secondary education institution
- Recent transcript
- List any awards/honors received / with copy of certificate(s) if possible
